The whole Morphic Liquid spray bottle is fully treated - and that includes the spray nozzle. With the first order for a Morphic Liquid Spray bottle, we also supply a refill bottle free of charge. When you have used all the Morphic Liquid and you purchase another refill bottle of Morphic Liquid, you must remember to refill the actual Morphic Liquid Spray bottle - you must not transfer the spray nozzle to the refill bottle!!!

We would recommend that you use the Morphic Liquid on such things as the TV glass screen, the perspex lid of the vinyl record player, glass or perspex or acrylic tables, large plastic surfaces, the glass faces of clocks etc. Also, very important, but not realised as important, any computer screen, computer plastic case etc IN OTHER ROOMS. Morphic Liquid can be used for large surfaces whereas the Cream-Electret only needs to be used in a small patch on a surface. One other thing. Whereas you would probably be reluctant to 'cream' the lenses of any spectacles you wear, if you apply Morphic Liquid to the lenses of spectacles, you will be amazed at the improvement in the 'sound'!!! when you are wearing the spectacles. There is a problem here howev-Once you take the spectacles off, the sound will be perceived as er. having deteriorated and the improvement in the sound will not come back until you wear the spectacles again!!

Other areas for using the Morphic Liquid are light bulbs, fluorescent tubes, digital display facias, in fact all glass and clear plastics - again also in rooms other than the listening room.
